

Dear Stake Youth and Adult Leaders,

Next **Wednesday, June 9th**, is the Stake Youth Activity (3:30-10:00 pm). A committee of youth from the stake has worked hard to plan a fun and engaging event. The success of the activity will require your help. Please help us to work out the following:

1. **Participation Count** – Please get an approximate count of potential youth and adult participants to Sister Claybaugh (claybaugh@gmail.com or text: 801 787-0055) by Sunday, June 6th. This will enable us to better estimate the amount of food we need.
2. **Permission forms** – All youth must have a Church permission form as well as a CLAS Ropes Course permission form signed by their parents. All adults should also sign a CLAS Ropes permission form. Class and Quorum presidencies could be asked to collect these ahead of time.
3. **Transportation** – Each ward is asked to provide transportation to the activity. We need to meet at the Stake Center at 3:30 pm. (Sorry about the early start time, but we had to work around the availability of the missionaries at the Orem Temple site.) Parking is limited at the temple site and at the ropes course. Do your best to fill every seatbelt.
4. **Activity Rotations** – At the CLAS Ropes Course, we will divide into groups and rotate through the activities. Youth will be given some choice of their groups, but we want to encourage interaction between wards too. We need adults to rotate with a group, or to monitor groups at each station. Please help with what you feel most comfortable doing. (No preparation is needed before hand).

Activity Timeline

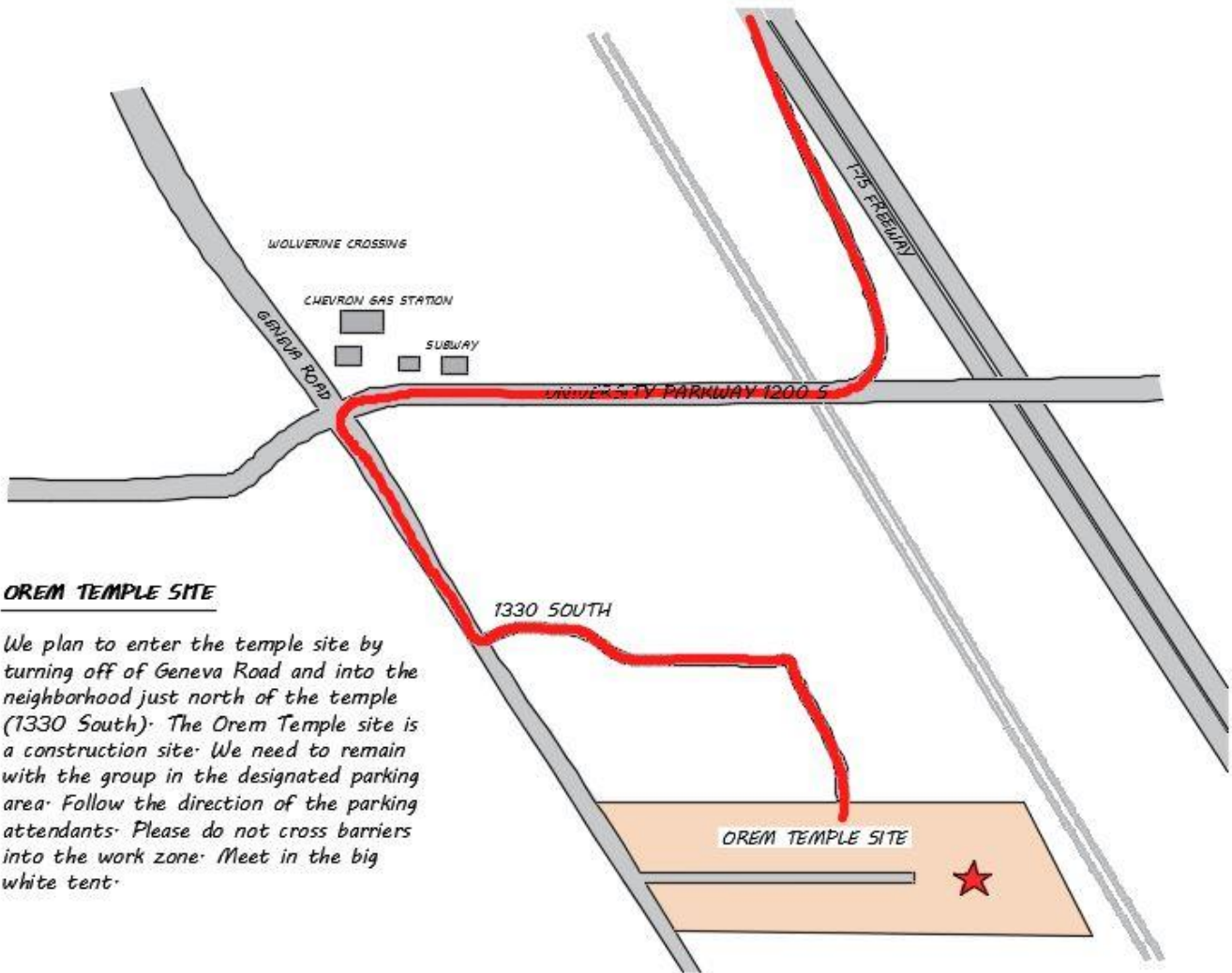
- 3:30 pm Meet at the Stake Center
- 3:45 Travel to the Orem Temple construction site
- 4:00-4:30 Missionary Presentation and group picture
- 4:30 Travel to CLAS Ropes Course (3606 W Center, Provo – almost to Utah Lake State Park)
- 5:00 Dinner at CLAS Ropes (or nearby)
- 5:30 Divide into groups by choice of activities
- 5:45-8:15 Group rotations (Canoeing, Tower, Zipline, Gaga Ball, Climbing Wall, etc.)
- 8:15-9:30 Open activity time (music, games, ropes course, canoes, etc.)
- 9:45 Closing
- 10:00 pm Return Home

We hope that you will be able to join us for the entire activity, but you could work out meeting us at one of the locations if necessary. Please work out the transportation ahead of time.

Attached to this email you will find the two permission forms, the flyer, a map of how to enter the Orem Temple site and a general layout of the CLAS Ropes Course.

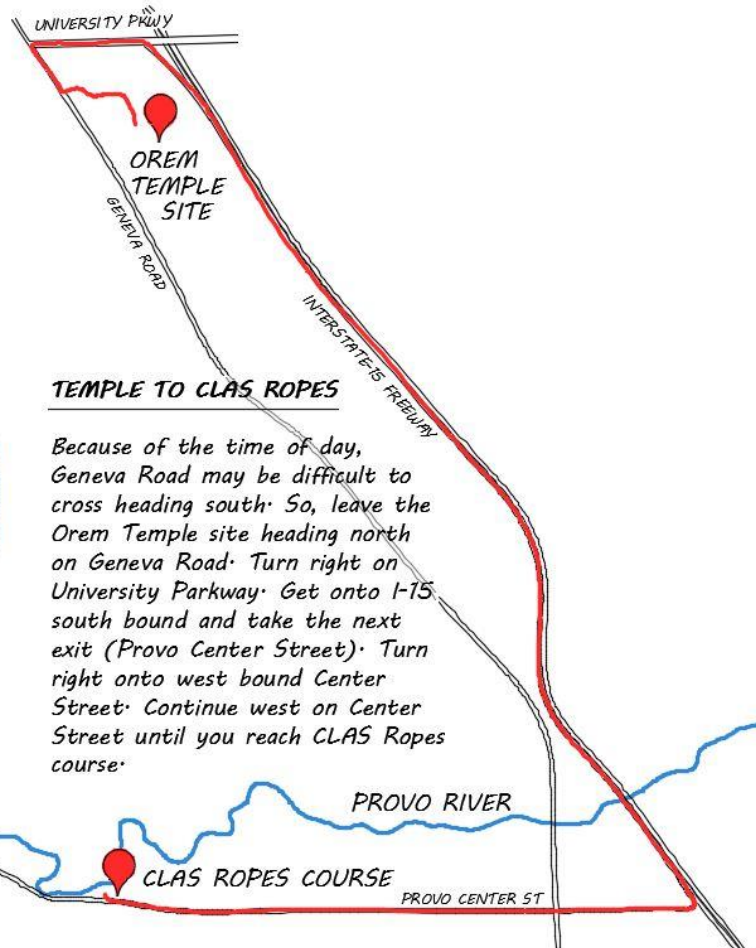

OREM TEMPLE SITE

We plan to enter the temple site by turning off of Geneva Road and into the neighborhood just north of the temple (1330 South). The Orem Temple site is a construction site. We need to remain with the group in the designated parking area. Follow the direction of the parking attendants. Please do not cross barriers into the work zone. Meet in the big white tent.



TEMPLE TO CLAS ROPES

Because of the time of day, Geneva Road may be difficult to cross heading south. So, leave the Orem Temple site heading north on Geneva Road. Turn right on University Parkway. Get onto I-15 south bound and take the next exit (Provo Center Street). Turn right onto west bound Center Street. Continue west on Center Street until you reach CLAS Ropes course.
